Learning Journals

We will now be using Learning Journals, an online platform to record your child's learning. This will allow staff to record much more detailed observations and track children's learning better and will replace the Seesaw app that we currently use. Staff are being trained on the new software and beginning to record their observations. All parents will have their own login details which will be sent out via email, so please look out for these and if you have not received these then please .

Water Bottles

We are keen to find a more suitable way to give children access to drinking water throughout the day and we are asking that you provide your child with their own water bottle (or cup for babies), which can stay in the nursery. This will make it easier to ensure children have access to water and reduce the risk of cross contamination. Having their own bottle will make it easier for children to identify their own bottle also.
